# Modular Sound Enclosure for a Stamping Press

### **The Situation**

Kondex is a tier supplier for the agriculture industry, producing a broad range of engineered cutting components. They required an enclosure around a stamping process to reduce noise within the rest of the facility.



## The Challenge

The equipment to be housed was very large, requiring 19' tall walls as well as the need to access and move the equipment in and out of the enclosure for periodic maintenance.



#### **The Solution**

Incorporating 8' x 16' double doors — the dimensions of the opening required — into the enclosure would be heavy and impractical to use. PortaFab, instead, created bottom leaf doors that opened independently of the transom.

PortaFab recommended the use of the PortaMax-458S system with Steel Faced Fire and Sound panels for noise reduction, impact resistance, and cleanability.

To allow for servicing of the equipment, PortaFab's engineering department integrated a lower 8' x 10' double door section for day-to-day use in accessing the equipment and created an 8' x 6' transom panel for use when removing equipment from the room.
